Hit and Run

On May 4, 2018 at approximately 11:34 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the 9300 block of Center St for a report of a hit and run. The Manassas City Fire Department reported Engine 501 was struck by a vehicle that fled the scene. Officers located the suspect vehicle nearby and the driver was subsequently arrested. There were no injuries and minor damage was reported.

Breaking and Entering

On May 6, 2018 at approximately 1:08 a.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to a residence on the 9500 block of Buttonbush Ct for a report of a burglary that had just occurred. A juvenile resident reported he was at the top of the stairs when he observed the silhouette of a subject at the bottom of the stairs in the basement. The subject fled upon detection. The juvenile was unable to provide a suspect description. There were no signs of forced entry and nothing was reported missing. The investigation is on-going.

Driving Under the Influence

On May 6, 2018 at approximately 9:12 p.m., officers of the Manassas City Police Department responded to the intersection of Confederate Trl and Wharton Ct for a report of an accident. The investigation revealed the victim was travelling East on Confederate Trl when they were struck head-on by the suspect vehicle that was turning right onto Confederate Trl from Wharton Ct. The driver of the suspect vehicle was subsequently arrested and charged with Driving Under the Influence. There were no major injuries reported.
