# Fire Safety Tips For Vacation

### Hotels and Motels:

**When** you call to make your reservations, find out if the hotel or motel has smoke detectors and fire sprinklers.

**Upon** arrival, learn where the exits from your floor are located.

**Walk** to each exit, counting the number of doors between your room and the fire exit.

**Find** the fire alarms and fire extinguishers. Refresh your memory on how to use them.

**Never** smoke in bed. Careless handling of smoking materials is a major cause of fires.

**Know** how to shut the air conditioner off to prevent it from bringing smoke into your room, if there is a fire in the hotel.

**Read** the directions on your room telephone and know how to report an emergency.

**If the fire alarm sounds, take immediate action.** Feel your room door to determine if it is hot, if not open it slightly to determine if there is smoke or fire in the hallway. If conditions are dangerous keep your door closed and stay in your room.

**Use** the emergency phone numbers to let the hotel staff and fire department know where you are located. If the hallway is clear, evacuate the building using the emergency stairs. Follow the directions of the hotel staff and fire department.

### Campfires:

**Always** supervise children around fires, grills, and cooking.

**Everyone** must know **Stop, Drop & Roll** if clothes catch fire.

**Always** keep a fire extinguisher or source of water available.

**Maintain** a minimum of 3 foot clearance free of combustible or flammable vegetation and materials around campfires, cooking, and tents. Never start a campfire with a flammable liquid.

**Thoroughly** extinguish and soak all fires and turn off fuel-powered lanterns, stoves and other appliances before leaving the campsite or going to bed.
